Sub: Rate of Dearness Allowance applicable w.e.f. 01.07.2021 to Railway employees continuing to draw their pay in the pre-revised pay scale/ grade pay as per 6th Central Pay Commission.

Please refer to this Ministry's letter of even number dated 21.11.2019 (PC-VI/399, RBE No.201/2019) revising the rates of Dearness Allowance w.e.f. 01.07.2019 in respect of railway employees continuing to draw their pay in the pre-revised pay scale/ grade pay as per 6th Central Pay Commission.

2. The rate of DA admissible to railway employees of above category shall be enhanced from the existing rate of 164% to 189% w.e.f. 01.07.2021. The increase subsumes the additional installments arising on 01.01.2020 ,01.07.2020 and 01.01.2021 . The rate of Dearness Allowance for the period from 01.01.2020 till 30.06.2021 shall remain at 164%.

3. The provisions contained in Paras 3,4 & 5 of this Ministry's letter of even number dated 09.09.2008 (S.No. PC-VI/3, RBE No.106/2008) shall continue to be applicable while regulating Dearness Allowance under these orders.

4. This issues with the concurrence of the Finance Directorate of the Ministry of Railways.



विषय: छठवें केंद्रीय वेतन आयोग के अनुसार संशोधन - पूर्व वेतनमान/ग्रेड-पे में अपने वेतन का आहरण जारी रखने वाले रेल कर्मचारियों को 01.07.2021 से लागू महंगाई भत्ते की दर।

रेल मंत्रालय के दिनांक 21.11.2019 के समसंख्यक पत्र (क्रम सं. पीसी-VII/399, आरबीई सं. 201/2019) जो कि उन रेल कर्मचारियों, जो छठवें केंद्रीय वेतन आयोग के अनुसार संशोधन पूर्व वेतनमान/ग्रेड-पे में अपना वेतन आहरण कर रहे हैं, के संबंध में दिनांक 01.07.2019 से महंगाई भत्ते की दरों में संशोधन करने के संबंध में है, का अवलोकन करें।

2. उपरोक्त कोटि के रेल कर्मचारियों के लिए लागू महंगाई भत्ते की दर को दिनांक 01.07.2021 से मौजूदा 164% से 189% तक बढ़ा दिया जाएगा। यह वृद्धि 01.01.2020, 01.07.2020 और 01.01.2021 को होने वाली अतिरिक्त किशतों को समाहित करती है। 01.01.2020 से 30.06.2021 तक की अवधि के लिए महंगाई भत्ते की दर 164% रहेगी।

3. इस मंत्रालय के 09.09.2008 के समसंख्यक पत्र (क्रम सं.पीसी -VI/3, आरबीई सं. 106/2008) के पैरा 3, 4 एवं 5 में निहित उपबंध इन आदेशों के अंतर्गत महंगाई भत्ते का विनियमन करते समय लागू किए जाते रहेंगे।

4. इसे रेल मंत्रालय के वित्त निदेशालय की सहमति से जारी किया जा रहा है।




