(a): The number of corruption cases involving the personnel of Armed Forces since the year 2010 are as under:

Army	1046*
Navy	05
Indian Air Force	29

* figures from 2013 to 2021.

(b) & (c): There has been a decrease in number of corruption related complaints. The likely reasons for the same are as follows:

- (i) Strict action against delinquent personnel.
- (ii) Sensitisation of environment on severity of consequences.
- (iii) Regular promulgation of advisories and policies.
