RECONSIDERATION OF RETIREMENT AGE

1505. SHRI TEJASVI SURYA:

Will the **PRIME MINISTER** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government proposes to revise the age of superannuation of all Government employees after completing a maximum service period of 30 years or completing 60 years as per the date of birth, whichever is earlier, so as to have uniformity in civil services & also provide an opportunity for youth of the Nation in light of the available data on eligible youth for employment i.e., those who are borne after 2000;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) if not, whether there is any reconsideration regarding the age of retirement for Government employees; and
- (d) the measures taken by the Government to provide more employment for the youth in civil services?

Ministries/ Departments of the Central Government have been directed from time to time, to fill up vacant posts in a time bound manner. Rozgar Melas are organized by the Government for filling up vacancies in Mission Mode across all the Central Government Ministries/ Departments/ Central Public Sector Undertaking (CPSUs)/ Autonomous Bodies/ Education and Health Institutions etc.in a time bound manner, providing employment to youth in civil services.
