#2839. SHRI TEJVEER SINGH:

Will the **PRIME MINISTER** be pleased to state:

(a) whether Government is contemplating an early retirement scheme for Central Government employees, and the impact of its implementation on employees;(b) whether Government has formulated any scheme for Government employees who desire their retirement age to be increased (late retirement), and the conditions that would be applied for this; and(c) whether Government has any policy under which flexibility in retirement age could be granted to Government employees thereby allowing them to retire earlier or later as per their preference?

ANSWER

(c): The Central Government employees who fulfil the prescribed criteria have the option to seek early retirement available to them under Central Civil Services (Pension) Rules, 2021, All India Services (Death-cum-Retirement Benefits) Rules, 1958, etc.
